Points to consider when making an application – these may improve your chances!

Make sure your organisation has...

- A comprehensive, open and non discriminating constitution.
- A copy of any legally binding leases or licences in relation to the management of land or buildings.
- A set of accounts for the last 3 years.
- Planning permission and relevant drawings for any proposed buildings.
- A list of items required, costings and professional quotations.

You and your organisation should be prepared to answer questions such as...

- What are your organisation's aims?
- How is your organisation managed?
- How much are you membership fees?
- Are you affiliated to the National Governing Body for your sport?
- How many members and sections do you have?
- What is the need for the project?
- How many additional participants/members will there be after the project?
- Have you raised funds in the past, how do you plan to continue this in the future?

Capital Grants

The lottery funded capital scheme is used to improve facilities throughout Wales.

Capital funding is used to support the development of sport and physical activity primarily in areas of greatest need.

What is eligible?

Projects of £12,500 or more involving building and construction, playing areas, purchase of land or rights in land, and/or the purchase of equipment.

Community Chest

This is a National Lottery funded grant aid scheme. It is designed to encourage more people to become more physically active more often. The maximum grant is £1,000 in any 12 month period.

Purpose of the Scheme:

The main purpose of the scheme is to support good projects which will create new or improved sport and physical activity opportunities. The scheme is intended to support activities which:

- encourage more people to become more physically active more often;
- encourage volunteers and community champions by developing new sport and physical activity leaders, sports coaches and officials.

Minor Grants

Minor grants provide funding for projects that create new, additional or improved opportunities to play sport.

The scheme is used widely by the Council to encourage individuals, families and communities to become more active.

Grants from £750 - £10,000 can be awarded. The total project cost cannot exceed £12,500.

Overseas Support

This scheme helps fund overseas expeditions which will enhance the development of a sport.

Source of funding

The grant is limited to a contribution of up to 50% of the estimated costs of travel, safety equipment and other essential materials.

What is eligible ?

Ground breaking Welsh based expeditions which have the support of appropriate governing bodies of sport.

Who is eligible ?

The majority of expedition members need to qualify by birth, parentage or residence in Wales.

The Business Sponsorship Initiative Scheme for Sport

The scheme provides a vital link between the commercial sector and the development of grass-roots sport.

Awards range from a minimum of £300 (up to three sponsors can make up this amount - normally £100 per sponsor) and to a maximum of £50,000 for all applicants. Should your application be successful, we will match your sponsorship £ for £.

What is eligible?

Sponsorship agreements that either involve new or additional business investment.

Who is eligible?

Any properly constituted sports club/association or local authority, which is being sponsored by a commercial organisation.
